



NEW NURSE TRAINING SCENARIOS - 2

Log onto Triage Logic and use the following to scenarios to “triage” your patient. Be sure to read each protocol thoroughly including “More Appropriate Guideline” section. Do not skip any questions in any of the Dispositions.

1. Billy Bobb. DOB 1-2-97 Concern: diarrhea x 5 days. Has been on regular diet. 3 diarrhea stools per day, watery. No blood or mucous. Drinking juice and coke.
2. Samuel Glover- DOB -6 weeks-adjust date accordingly. Concern: fever today-99.5 rectal. Content and happy. Nursing well. No s/s of illness.
3. Hudson Dean- DOB-11 weeks- Concern: fever of 100.8-ax. Fussy and irritable all day. Has cold s/s. Not feeding well. Has on diaper, onesie and blanket.
4. Gracie Forrest-DOB-7-14-80-Concern: -26 weeks OB. Has had cold for several weeks. Cannot get rid of. Has tried Sudafed and Benadryl with no relief. EDC-adjust according to date to equal 26 weeks. G2/1. Past hx of Placenta Previa with last pregnancy. Delivered C-section after 4 hrs of labor. No complications this pregnancy. Positive fetal movement. Last office visit 2 days ago. No contractions, vaginal bleeding or discharge.
5. Mickey Mouse- DOB 2-14-06- Concern: Poisoning Found Aunt’s purse and took unknown quantity of Baby ASA from purse. Happened 10 minutes ago. Weight: 45 lbs. No s/s present. Playful, happy
6. Donald Duck-DOB 2-24-94-Concern: Depression/suicide: Grades have dropped. Not taking care of appearance. Not interested in playing games or visiting with friends. Makes comments that family would be better off if he was dead/gone. No active attempts at suicide, no plan.
7. Marcus Dolan-DOB 11-9-01-Concern: Swallowed a penny. No s/s of choking. Happened 30 minutes ago.
8. Phillip Brewer-DOB 7-1-00 -Concern: Swallowed a magnet from a toy, tiny 1-2 cm. Choked initially, now fine. No s/s Happened 15 minutes ago.
9. Margaret Bell-DOB 6-15-88-Concern: Condom is in vagina, unable to get out. What does she do?
10. Jennifer Greene-DOB: 7-15-05-Concern: Slipped in bathtub and was under water for several seconds-15-30. Inhaled water, coughing a lot initially. Acts fine now.

11. Gina Clodfelter-DOB: 8 weeks (adjust date)-Concern: Spitting up/reflux. Spitting up 1-2 tbsp after every feeding. Very fussy at night for several hours. Taking 4 ozs/2-3 hours. Stomach is tight.
12. Skylar Robbins-DOB : 3 mos.(adjust date)-Concern: wants to change formula tonight. Has been on Similac Advanced. Keeps spitting up. Has tried 3 different formulas for several days each and nothing is working. Has not talked with doctor about problems.
13. Joseph Ellis-DOB 1-22-90-Concern: Was roller skating at City Park and fell hitting head. Was not wearing helmet. Fell backwards and hit head on concrete. Has large 50 cent piece knot on head, hard to touch, tender. No LOC, change in behavior. PEARL. Has ice to lump.
14. Jane Browne-DOB 3-14-08-Concern: fell down flight of steps hitting hard wood floor. Happened 1 hr ago. Has vomited x 3. Unable to keep awake. Unable to sit up, keeps falling backwards onto couch. Mom has to hold up. Did have LOC for about 30 sec.
15. Susan Flowers-DOB 4 days ago-Concern: Umbilical cord is oozing yellow drainage-smells foul. Red around cord. Mom states that no one gave her instructions in Umbilical care at hospital.
16. Robbi Roberts-DOB 9-6-63Concern: Burn to left arm while working on car. About 2 inches in diameter with blisters, some are broken. Very painful.
17. Yellow Fellow-DOB 12-24-09-Concern: The dog has fleas. Sleeps with the kids in their bed. Will the child get fleas too?
18. Carol Brady-DOB 11-22-70-Concern: Has hemorrhoids. Can see them. Very painful when wiping, some bleeding.
19. Julia Child-DOB 4-5-60-Concern: BS is 360. On Lantis 25 units nightly. No SS insulin in use. No s/s.
20. Sally Sudds-DOB 8-1-62-Concern: BP 150/90 with manual cuff. Has HA, blurred vision, nausea. No pain. Does not take BP meds

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
