PRESENTING SYMPTOM	CRITICAL ISSUES TO CONSIDER
NEUROLOGICAL	 Brain hemorrhage Stroke Head injury
ENDOCRINE	 Diabetics Thyroid storm Adrenal diseases
CARDIAC	 Heart attack Diabetics are tired & weak Aortic aneurisms
ORTHOPEDIC	 In kids: what would make you send them in to the ER for sure, every single time? A deformity after a fall, a limp, which is never normal in kids (this will be a sceptic knee or joint), abuse.
RESPIRATORY	 CHF Asthma COPD Pulmonary embolism Drowning – in younger kids
GI	In kids: vomiting and diarrhea, obstruction of bowel, appendix, bleed
OB/GYN	 Atopic pregnancy Preterm labor Decreased fetal movement Undetected abortion Preeclampsia
NEWBORNS	What can nurses miss when it comes to temperature? Everyone knows 100.4 or higher in a newborn. Nurses may miss hypothermia.
DERMATOLOGY	 Sceptic – in children Strep rash Necrosis
PSYCHOLOGICAL	 Suicidal thoughts Abuse Manic Associative episodes
